Details of University Adherence to FERPA Requirements

Generally, it is Drake University's policy to request a signed ciand accountability in student development.

There is no law forbidding students from voluntarily sharing information with parents after the student receives it from the University, and no consent form is required for such voluntary sharing between student and parent.

Under the following special circumstances, the University may release student education records to parents or others without student consent:

In an emergency, federal law (FERPA) allows the University to contact parents and other appropriate persons and disclose the information necessary to protect the health or safety of the mer orientation. Students in the parents access to their record via
